PRESCRIBING SCHOOL

Lord of the lagna

Prescribes the gems of the 1st, 9th and 5th lords as the life stone, the lucky stone and the benefic stone. Strengthening the lord of the lagna is safe for the native by definition, which is the argument for the school. It withholds a gem only when its graha owns nothing but dusthanas, so the list of exclusions is usually empty.

How to read this report

A gem in Jyotish is prescribed neither from a Sun sign nor from character, but from which houses a graha owns measured from your lagna. So the whole report rests on one point: the ascendant at the moment of birth, and it is through that point that a stone is recommended for one person and withheld from another. The two schools implemented here arrive at the same three gems, because a functional benefic is a graha owning a trikona and the trikona lords are the lords of the 1st, 5th and 9th. They differ in the ordering, in the role each stone carries, and in what they refuse to give.

House ownership from the lagna

This school reads only the trikona lords and the case of a graha owning nothing but dusthanas. It passes no functional verdict on each graha, so no role column is shown here: the other school would fill it differently.

Ruby

LIFE STONE (JEEVAN RATNA)

Manikya · Corundum (red)

Carries the Sun · lord of the 1st house (Leo)

Ruby is worn as the karaka of the Sun, which classical texts assign to vitality, authority, the father, and standing in the eyes of others. Where the Sun is the graha a chart depends on, the stone is worn to keep that significator in view rather than to add anything to it.

Manuals put ruby on the ring finger and set it in gold or copper, and ask that it be a natural stone rather than a treated one.

LUCKY STONE (BHAGYA RATNA)

Moonga · Corallium rubrum

Carries Mars · lord of the 9th house (Aries)

Red coral is the karaka of Mars: initiative, the brother, contest, and the capacity to finish what argument starts. It is organic rather than mineral, which is why the manuals treat its lifespan as finite and expect it to be replaced.

Copper or gold, ring finger. Coral is the one gem in the set that is farmed, and provenance is a real question rather than a formality.

Yellow sapphire

BENEFIC STONE (KARAKA RATNA)

Pukhraj · Corundum (yellow)

Carries Jupiter · lord of the 5th house (Sagittarius)

Yellow sapphire is the karaka of Jupiter: the teacher, counsel, law, and what the texts call dharma, the sense of what is owed. It is the stone most often prescribed as a general benefic, which is exactly why a school that prescribes by house ownership may withhold it.

Gold, index finger. The colour range accepted is wide, and a pale stone is not a weaker one.

Context only. Both schools prescribe by house ownership rather than by strength, so dignity and combustion do not change the list above.

Method and limits

The gem-to-graha mapping is classical: the Garuda Purana and Varahamihira's Brihat Samhita, chapter 80. Day, finger, metal, weight and mantra belong to modern practice rather than to scripture, and the manuals disagree, so a range and the variants are given instead of one number presented as canon. The first-wearing date is found by scanning the Panchang: over the next sixty days, the best-rated day that falls on this graha's own weekday. Days rated poor or avoid are never offered, and if no day clears that floor the report says so.

Rahu and Ketu own no sign, so neither school reaches hessonite or cat's eye from the lagna. They are prescribed on a specific reason, which is a separate judgement from the one this report makes.

A traditional remedial prescription, informational only. Gem identity, treatment and weight must be confirmed by a qualified gemmologist or jeweller before purchase, and no gemstone is a substitute for medical care: consult a licensed physician for any health concern.
